Participants must have swum in at least half of the schedule meets with their team during the current season. 8th graders who meet the above criteria are eligible to score. There will be no exhibition-only swimmers, however, if a swimmer is officially entered in one individual event, they may swim one other individual event as exhibition. Per VISAA rules, 7th graders are not eligible to compete. No swimmer may swim more than 4 total events, with no more than 2
	individual events
Events:	 Same Order of Events as the regular season with boys swimming first. Because Diving will be completed before the meet, we will skip the Diving Events (#9 and #10) and jump from event #8 to event #11. All events will be swum as timed finals.
Diving	The Diving portion of the meet will occur prior to the swimming competition.
	• The competition will consist of six (6) scoring Dives.
	• The competition will be recorded as required by this year's virtual State Championship rules.
	The diving competition will be planned and executed by the diving coaches. Diving coaches should contact Seton Diving Coaches Seamus Koehr (koehr@cua.edu) and Ashley Keapproth (akeapproth@gmail.com).
	• Please, diving entries should be submitted with the Swimming entries in the Team Manager Entry file as event 9 (boys) and 10 (girls) so the scorer does not have to enter the names by hand.

From I-66, points East and North

Take I-66 to Exit 43 South, Route 29 South toward Warrenton. Go about 10 miles to the first Warrenton Exit for Business 29 (do not get on the Route 17 bypass). Follow Business 29 through Warrenton, past Route 17 to Route 211 by Fosters Grill. Turn Right on Route 211, go through the light and turn into the driveway behind the WARF. The entrance is around to the front.

From I-66 points West

Take I-66 to Exit 28 South, Route 17 South toward Warrenton. Go about 10 miles to a left turn at the stoplight at Business 29 (blockbuster will be on your left). Follow Business 29 through Warrenton to Route 211 by Fosters Grill. Turn Right on Route 211, go through the light and turn into the driveway behind the WARF. The entrance is around to the front.

From I-95 and points South

Exit 95 onto Route 17 North (exit 133). The exit is just north of Fredericksburg, right after you cross the Rappahannock River. Follow 17 N to Opal (at a Sheetz). Turn right onto Route 29/17. Go about 6 miles to the first Warrenton exit for Business 29. Turn left into Warrenton and follow Business 29 (Shirley Avenue) to Route 211. Turn left on Route 211, go through the light and turn into the driveway behind the WARF. The entrance is around to the front.

Coaches Meeting

• A Zoom Coaches Meeting was be scheduled prior to the meet if a school is participating who has not previously participated in a Seton meet.

Pool Entry

- Swimmers and Coaches will enter through the front door of the Fitch WARF with a mask on.
- At that point, they will be screened, have their temperature taken, and proceed to their team area.

Masks

- All swimmers, coaches and officials will be required to wear a mask anytime they are out of the water.
- Swimmers should report to the blocks for their event with a mask on.
- Just prior to the beginning of their event, they may remove their mask, wrap it in their towel, and put their towel on the chair provided behind each lane.

Locker Rooms and Restrooms

- The locker rooms are closed for changing, so swimmers must arrive to and leave the meet with their swimsuits under their clothing.
 - o The locker rooms may be used for brief restroom visits only.

Team Areas

- Each team will be assigned a team area large enough to allow for social distancing.
 - o Because no spectators are allowed in the Fitch WARF, Trinity Christian will have the entire bleacher area above the pool.
 - Seton, Highland, and RMA will be assigned large areas on the deck around the pool.
 - It is the responsibility of each Coach to enforce the wearing of masks and social distancing.
- Meet Programs will be posted in multiple places in each team area to prevent congregating around the postings.
- Meet Programs will also be posted on www.setonswimming.org in advance of the meet. Swimmers should arrive at the meet knowing their heat and lane assignments.

Additional COVID Protocols (cont'd)

Movement Around the Pool

- To minimize contact between swimmers, a designated one-way lane for pedestrian traffic will be established around the entire perimeter of the pool.
 - The lane will be marked with Stanchions and/or painter's tape.
- Swimmers may only move around the pool in the <u>clockwise</u> direction.
- The flow for Trinity Christian teammembers will be from the bleachers:
 - Of Going to the pool area: Trinity swimmers will go down the steps, enter the leisure pool area, immediately turn right to enter the competition pool area staying to the right of the stanchions, and enter the traffic lane toward the Clerk of the Course.
 - Leaving the pool area: Trinity swimmers will exit their lanes to the right, follow the traffic lane clockwise around the pool, exit the pool area to the right of stanchions into the leisure pool area, and proceed back up the steps to the bleachers.

Warm-up

- Warm-up lane assignments are designed so that there are only four (4) swimmers per lane, with two (2) starting in the water on each end.
- Experience has taught us that assigning swimmers to a warm-up lane and end of the pool prior to the meet is enormously helpful in keeping the warm-up organized.
- Teams may use the blocks to practice starts, but only one (1) swimmer may be out of the water at a time in each lane.
- Continuous warm-down lanes will be available, but no more than four (4) swimmers will be allowed in each lane first come, first served. Please try to respect the fact that the most competitive swimmers have the greatest need.

Additional COVID Protocols (cont'd)

Clerk of the Course

- To prevent heats of swimmers from being forced to congregate behind the blocks as they await their heats, we will implement a Clerk of the Course.
- The Clerk of the Course will consist of marked corrals for the next two (2) heats.
 - o For relays, only one heat will stage in the Clerk of the Course.
 - O It is important that swimmers do not report to the Clerk of the Course before space is available.
- Swimmers will flow to and from their heat in the following manner:
 - When a heat finishes, those swimmers will remain in the water until the next heat starts over top of them (i.e., a "flyover start").
 - For backstroke, swimmers will not advance to the blocks from the Clerk of the Course until the previous swimmers have exited the water and cleared the area.
 - Swimmers will then exit the pool, don their masks, and exit clockwise around the pool back to their team area.
 - Once these swimmers have cleared the area behind the blocks, the next heat will advance to their positions behind the blocks, remove their masks, wrap them in their towels, and leave them on the chair provided.
 - Other swimmers in the Clerk of Course area will advance to the next closest corral.
