	• Each team may enter up to four (4) scoring swimmers for each individual
	event and up to two (2) relays for each relay event.
	• Entries must include seed times. Seed times should be either actual or
	converted short-course yard times. For "B" Relays, please make the best seed
	time estimate possible.
	No exhibition-only swimmers are allowed in this championship meet.
	However, if you have a swimmer entered in only one official event, they may swim in one other event as exhibition. This may result in more than four (4) swimmers entered in a single individual event.
	• Except for relay line-ups, all entries are final once they are submitted.

Timers:	Timing will be done using the Colorado Timing System.		
	• To back up the CTS, two timers will have a CTS backup button.		
	<ul> <li>Each lane will also have one Dolphin electronic stopwatch as a tertiary backup.</li> <li>We will run the meet with two (2) timer per lane.</li> <li>Because of the scale of this meet and the difficulty in managing the number of parent volunteers, we have assigned the timing responsibilities for each lane to a specific school, relying heavily on the schools who are not traveling great distances. 	o The announcer will announce the event

	o The starter will simply say "Take Your Mark" and a horn will signal the

• To encourage team solidarity and spirit, each team will be assigned a team area.
Teams are strongly encouraged to bring banners and posters to display in their
team area. The Freedom Center does not allow us to hang banners on the walls
with anything except blue painter's tape.
Teams are strongly encouraged to do team cheers prior to the start of the meet
and during the breaks
• Swimmers should not be hanging out in the lobby. All swimmers should remain
in the pool area to cheer (loudly) for their fellow swimmers.

# Additional COVID Protocols

COVID Protocols have been greatly relaxed from last season, but there are still some important policies in place.

COVID Protocols for this meet will be guided by the policies of George Mason University and The Freedom Center. It is a privilege for Seton to be able to host this meet, but to maintain that privilege, all participating teams must be very diligent in adhering to the following simplified protocols: Pool Entry

• Swimmers, Coaches, and Spectators will enter through the side door of the Freedom Center with a mask on. <u>DO NOT</u> enter through the front door of the facility.



• At that point, they will be screened, have their temperature taken, and proceed to their team area.

#### Masks

- All swimmers, coaches and officials will be required to wear a mask anytime they are out of the water.
- Swimmers should report to the blocks for their event with a mask on. Just prior to the beginning of their event, they may remove their mask, wrap it in their towel, and put their towel on the chair provided behind each lane.

#### Locker Rooms and Restrooms

• The locker rooms are open, but masks are still required inside the locker room, particularly when other Freedom Center patrons are present.

#### **Team Areas**

- The Freedom Center has no social distancing requirements, so team areas will be assigned on deck as we have always done prior to COVID.
  - It is the responsibility of each Coach to enforce the wearing of masks.

# Clerk of the Course

#### Clerk of the Course

- There will be no Clerk of the Course for this meet.
- Swimmers are expected to report directly behind the blocks in time for their event.

#### **Spectators**

- We will allow spectators inside the Freedom Center bleacher area on a trial basis.
- Masks are required for all spectators per George Mason University policy.
  - o If you object to wearing a mask, as many people do, then please just watch the meet on the livestream.
- The Meet Host has no interest in policing this policy.
  - O Please do not put him in this position.
  - If a spectator is seen without a mask, he will identify the school from which that spectator came and inform that coach that their none of their parents will be allowed into the meet again.
    - We cannot allow a spectator to risk our ability to host meets

#### **GMU Health Check**

- The GMU Health Check is also required for 20% all athletes, coaches, and parents. The website will issue a green screen that permits entry.
