

Meet Format:	• The meet will use a championship, timed finals format. All heats will be seeded based entry times.
Senior	The Senior Parade will be supervised by Trinity Christian School.
Parade	• Seniors should report, in their team uniforms (i.e., not swimming suits), to the Announcing station immediately after the conclusion of the Session II warm-up to be lined up as instructed.
Events:	• Same Order of Events as the regular season with boys swimming first.
	• Because Diving will compete separately, during the swimming competition, we will skip the Diving Events (#9 and #10) and jump from event #8 to event #11.
	• All events will be swum as timed finals.
Eligibility	 Participants must be enrolled in, and in good standing with, a Virginia private school that is a member of the Virginia Christian Athletic Conference (VCAC). Participants must have swum in at least half of the schedule meets with their team during the season
	• 8 th graders who meet the above criteria are eligible to score
	• There will be no exhibition-only swimmers , however, if a swimmer is officially entered in one individual event, they may swim one other individual event as exhibition.
	• Divers who are also swimmers may be entered into two (2) individual swimming events, but they must be marked as exhibition for at least one of the three (3) individual events so that they do not exceed the number of allowable scoring entries for an individual.
	• Per VISAA rules, 7 th graders are not eligible to compete.
	• No swimmer may swim more than 4 total events, with no more than 2 individual events
Diving	 Diving Coaches should contact Seton Coach Ashley Keapproth, <u>akeapproth@gmail.com</u>, for all things related to the diving competition. The Diving portion of the meet will occur prior to the swimming competition Diving will follow the 6-Dive format per NFHS rules. The [front] category will be the required group. The 5 optional dives must be from at least 4 categories.
	• Diving entries should be submitted with the Swimming entries in the Team Manager Entry file as event 9 (boys) and 10 (girls).
Scoring:	 The meet will be scored in the following manner: For individual events, the first 12 places will be awarded points in the following manner: 16-13-12-11-10-9-7-5-4-3-2-1
	• For relay events, the first 12 places will be awarded points in the following manner: 32-26-24-22-20-18-14-10-8-6-4-2

Entries:	• All entries are due by the Tuesday before the Meet at 6:00 p.m.
2110100	 All teams must submit entries via a Hy-tek Team Manager export file. No
	manual entries will be accepted.
	• Each team may enter up to four (4) scoring swimmers for each individual
	event.
	• Each team may enter both an "A" and a "B" Relay for each relay event, but the "B" Relay must be marked as exhibition.
	• Entries must include seed times. Seed times should be either actual or converted short-course yard times. For "B" Relays, please make the best seed time estimate possible.
	• No exhibition-only swimmers are allowed in this championship meet.
	However, if you have a swimmer entered in only one official event, they may swim in one other event as exhibition. This may result in more than four (4) swimmers entered in a single individual event.
	• Except for relay line-ups, all entries are final once they are submitted.
	• Send entries to Scorer Bill Dealey at <u>sst@dealey.com</u>
	• Once entries are received, the person submitting those entries will receive
	confirmation from Mr. Dealey by the Wednesday evening before the Meet.
Relay Entries	 Relay entries may be submitted with or without the specific swimmers listed, but they will not be final until official relay cards are submitted to the Meet Scorer. The meet host would appreciate a projected lineup for each relay with your entries to reduce the data entry during the meet.
	• Official entries for the 200 Medley relay must be submitted 30 minutes prior to the start of meet.
	• Official entries for the 200 Freestyle relay and the 400 freestyle relays must be submitted prior to the end of the boys 500 Free (prior to event #15).
	• Swimmers whose names are submitted on the relay cards must swim that event, in the order listed on the card, unless the referee allows for a substitution because of injury or illness.
Seeding:	• All events will be pre-seeded by the scorers and lanes will be assigned based on the times submitted by the coaches.
	• Heats will be seeded from slowest to fastest.
	• Realistic relay times for the anticipated line-up would be appreciated.

USA Observed Swims	 Times swum by USA swimmers at this meet will be recognized by Virginia Swimming IF we can provide the names of two (2) USA-certified Stroke & Turn officials who will officiate the meet. There have been many changes implemented for USA Swimming's national
	database, SWIMS. To ensure that times are recorded properly by Virginia Swimming, Coaches should ensure that your USA Swimmers are entered with using the legal first and last names and birthdate that correspond to their USA Swimming registration. To ensure that this happens, please update your Team Manager software with that information. The good news is that member IDs are no longer needed for USA-S registered athletes.
Timers:	Timing will be done using the Colorado Timing System.
	• To back up the CTS, two timers will have a CTS backup button.
	• Each lane will also have one Dolphin electronic stopwatch as a tertiary backup.
	• We will run the meet with two (2) timer per lane. Timing responsibilities for
	each lane will be assigned to a specific school. Lane assignments will be published separately with the warm-up schedule.
	• Each responsible school may recruit and substitute their timers however they
	wish, as long as there are always two (2) timers present during the competition.
	• If your school is not specifically listed, please plan on providing at least one timer if you are able. A shared burden is not heavy.
Starting	The Referee and Starter will use a whistle start procedure for this meet.
Procedures	• Whistle start procedures are used in USA Swimming and will be used at the VISAA State Championship meet.
	 The procedure will be as follows:
	 4 of 5 consecutive whistles means get ready
	• The announcer will announce the event
	 1 long whistle means to step up on the block
	• For backstroke only, there will be another long whistle in lieu of a
	command to place your feet
	 The starter will simply say "Take Your Mark" and a horn will signal the start.
	 We will use dive-over starts to expedite the meet.

Directions:	From I-66, points East and North Take I-66 to Exit 43 South, Route 29 South toward Warrenton. Go about 10 miles to the first Warrenton Exit for Business 29 (do not get on the Route 17 bypass). Follow Business 29 through Warrenton, past Route 17 to Route 211 by Fosters Grill. Turn Right on Route 211, go through the light and turn into the driveway behind the WARF. The entrance is around to the front.
	From I-66 points West Take I-66 to Exit 28 South, Route 17 South toward Warrenton. Go about 10 miles to a left turn at the stoplight at Business 29 (blockbuster will be on your left). Follow Business 29 through Warrenton to Route 211 by Fosters Grill. Turn Right on Route 211, go through the light and turn into the driveway behind the WARF. The entrance is around to the front.
	From I-95 and points South Exit 95 onto Route 17 North (exit 133). The exit is just north of Fredericksburg, right after you cross the Rappahannock River. Follow 17 N to Opal (at a Sheetz). Turn right onto Route 29/17. Go about 6 miles to the first Warrenton exit for Business 29. Turn left into Warrenton and follow Business 29 (Shirley Avenue) to Route 211. Turn left on Route 211, go through the light and turn into the driveway behind the WARF. The entrance is around to the front.
