Eligibility	<ul> <li>Participants must be enrolled in, and in good standing with, a Virginia private school that is a member of VISAA Division II (Less than 160 boys or less than 160 girls in the student population, grades 9-12).</li> <li>Participants must have swum in at least half of the schedule meets with their team during the season</li> <li>8<sup>th</sup> graders who meet the above criteria are eligible to score</li> <li>There will be <b>no exhibition-only swimmers</b>, however, if a swimmer is officially entered in one individual event, they may swim in one other individual event as exhibition.</li> <li>Per VISAA rules, 7<sup>th</sup> graders are not eligible to compete.</li> <li>No swimmer may swim more than 4 total events, with no more than 2 individual events.</li> <li>Divers that are also swimmers many compete in one (1) extra individual swim event as "exhibition".</li> </ul>
