Entry Rules:	Individual Events
•	o An eligible swimmer may swim in no more than two individual
	events.
	 Each team is allowed unlimited entries in individual events, but only a team's top four (4) swimmers are eligible to score.
	o All non-scoring entries should be designated as "exhibition"
	O Divers that are also swimmers many compete in one (1) extra
	individual event as "exhibition".
	• Relays
	O An eligible swimmer may swim up to three relay events as long as
	that swimmer's total number of event entries, including individual
	events, does not exceed four (4).
	 Each team may enter any number of relays, but only relays
	designated "A" and "B" will be eligible to score.
	 Non-scoring relay entries should be designated as "exhibition".
	o Relays may be entered without swimmer's names, but the meet host
	would appreciate a projected relay line up with all entries.
	o 200 Medley Relay cards specifying the actual relay line-up shall be
	submitted to the designated official thirty (30) minutes prior to the
	start of the Meet.
	o 200 and 400 Free Relay cards specifying the actual relay line-up shall
	be submitted to the designated official prior to the conclusion of
	the Men's 500 Freestyle.
	Swimmers whose names are submitted on the relay cards must
	swim in that event, in the order listed on the card, unless the referee
	allows for a substitution because of injury or illness.

Diving	The Diving portion of the meet will occur prior to the swimming competition
	 Diving will follow the 6-Dive format per NFHS rules.
	The Reverse category will be the required group per the VISAA-approved weekly rotation.
	o The 5 optional dives must be from at least 4 categories.
	• Exhibition divers are permitted, but they must be capable of
	performing a 6-Dive list that complies with all requirements above.
	• Diving Sheets must be completed, signed, and turned at least 20 minutes before the start of the competition.
	All Coaches and Officials will meet 10 minutes before the start of the competition
	Visiting teams should provide qualified volunteers for judging and
	scoring. Coaches who plan to judge should sign up also. Please use this



Entry
Submission and
Fees:

- All entries are due by 6:00 p.m. on the Thursday before the Meet.
- All entries must be submitted with a Hy-Tek Team Manager entry file. No manual or hard-copy entries will be accepted.
- Entries must include first and last name, gender, grade, and seed times. Seed times should be either actual or converted short-course yard times. Because this Meet is so early in the season, coach's times (estimates or practice times) are not only acceptable, they are encouraged if no other time is available so that swimmers can get in competitive heats.
- Except for relays, all scoring entries are final once the Psych Sheet is published, usually the day prior to the Meet.
 - o For individual events, only scratches or additions can be accepted.
 - o Text Mike Judge at (443) 564-1665 with last-minute changes.
- Submit entries by importing a Team Manager entry file into SwimCloud on the Home page for the meet. Click on the three dots beside your team's name and select "Import Entries":



- Once submitted, the person who e-mailed the entries will receive a confirmation e-mail with an attached list of that team's official entries. It is the responsibility of the person submitting the entries to verify that the entries were received and that they were received accurately.
- The Meet Team Entry Fees:
 - O To cover the cost of the pool, each Swim team will be asked to contribute \$225.00 which will roughly split the cost evenly across all teams.
 - Please ensure that checks are received on or before the day of the Meet
 - Diving Teams will be asked to contribute \$50 for 1-4 divers, \$100 for 5-9 divers, \$150 for 10-15 divers, and \$200 for more than 15 divers.
- The fee should be mailed, with a note specifying the date of the Meet, to:

Seeding:	 All events will be seeded in advance and lanes will be assigned based on the times submitted by the coaches. Heats will be seeded from slowest to fastest. Swimmers entered without a seed time, will automatically be seeded in the slowest heat – so please put a time on every entry possible, even it is a coach's time (i.e., estimate). If every team submits their entries on time, a preliminary Psych Sheet and meet program will be distributed via e-mail prior to the day of the Meet.
Scoring:	 Every team in meet will be scored against every other team in the meet using a 3+ Dual Meet format. Points will be awarded as follows: For individual events, the first 7 places will be awarded points in the following manner: 8-6-5-4-3-2-1. For relay events, the first 3 places will be awarded points in the following manner: 10-5-3

Stroke & Turn Officials	 Each team is responsible for providing at least two (2) certified Stroke & Turn officials. If more officials volunteer, the Meet Referee will be able to rotate officials into periodic breaks. Officials should dress for the role: a white polo shirt or blouse; navy blue shorts, pants, or skirt; and white socks and shoes. Timing:	Timing will be done using the Colorado Timing System.
	• To back up the CTS, two timers will have a CTS backup button.
	• Each lane will also have one Dolphin electronic stopwatch as a tertiary backup.
	• We will run the meet with two (2) timer per lane. Timing responsibilities for each lane will be assigned to a specific school. Lane assignments will be published separately with the warm-up schedule.
Awards:	The Meet Host has purchased two beautiful cups to be instituted as traveling trophies for the boys and girls team champions.
	• The trophies will be awarded immediately after the completion of the swimming competition and team handshakes
	• The meet host will arrange for the trophies to be engraved with each year's champions.
	• It is hoped that last year's boys' champion, Seton School, and last year's girls' champion, Trinity Christian, will return to the meet this year with the trophies so they may travel home with the new champions.
	 Based on a vote of the Coaches prior to the end of the Meet, the following special awards will also be given: Swimmer of the Meet (boy and girl) Coach of the Year (Boys' team and Girls' team)
	• Medals will be handed out after the meet for 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd place in each event
	 Medals will be awarded at breaks after the 50 Free, 200 Free Relay and at the end of the Meet. Top-3 finishers should gather under the scoreboard and walk across
	the bulkhead to receive their medals. This will have them facing the spectators and the livestream cameras.
	• Coaches, if you have a gold medalist, you are welcome to join me on the bulkhead to give the medal to your swimmer.

	command to place your feet	
	 The starter will simply say "Take Your Mark" and a horn will signal the start. 	
	We will use dive-over starts to keep the meet moving quickly. Swimmers	
	should not exit the pool until the next heat has started over top of them.
